During this special emphasis month, celebrate your congregation's involvement with LSC and rejoice in what we have accomplished together. Remember God's love and never forget His call to walk with and serve those in need.

LSC depends on our partnerships with congregations across the Carolinas. Over the last year, your LSC ministry:

- helped 61 veterans transition from homelessness back to self-sufficiency.
- improved the lives of 347 children in foster care.
- provided services and support to 525 refugees.
- placed 21 children in loving adoptive homes.
- improved the lives of 48 people battling severe and persistent mental illness.
- helped 262 families avoid homelessness through supportive services and life-training skills.
- supported 85 people with developmental disabilities or varying life challenges.
