## In 2013, your LSC ministry:

- Provided 364,419 days of care and services to 2,269 NC seniors through retirement, skilled nursing, assisted living, and adult day services.
- Cared for approximately 350 nursing home residents with a dementia-related diagnosis. In addition, nearly 500 senior services employees received training from the nationally recognized Alzheimer's Resource Center of Connecticut.
- Launched a geriatric care management program, which has helped 101 elders live safely in whatever place they call home.
- Supported caregivers and care receivers by providing direct services to 94 clients and respite and supplementary services to 49 caregivers.
- Collaborated with 2,079 volunteers who provided 29,346 hours of volunteer services to the LSC ministries. In return, LSC residents, staff members, and families donated more than 8,700 hours of service back to their communities.
- Continued construction of a skilled care nursing home on the Trinity Elms campus in Clemmons. The home, which will offer a hydrotherapy pool to enhance its rehabilitation program, is scheduled for completion in May 2014.
