Children's Sermon

Good morning. Do you ever forget things or forget to do something? Like leaving a book at school or not putting a toy away? Do you know any adults who forget things? We all forget things sometimes. What are some ways that can help us remember...maybe writing it down, or the old-fashioned trick of tying a string around our fingers?

Now, I want to tell you about the LSC elephant. It is well known in the animal world that elephants have really good memories. They never forget a face, and they can remember where to find food or water even if they have been away from an area for awhile. The LSC elephant is a friend of a ministry called Lutheran Services Carolinas, or LSC for short. LSC helps children and other people who are in need.

Everyone who works at LSC wants to create good memories for the children and grown-ups in their care who may not have a home or a family of their own. We all want people who are hurting to remember that God has not forgotten about them. God loves them and is looking out for them, just like God looks out for you and me. Some churches have even made stuffed animal versions of the LSC elephant so the children in LSC's care will have a constant reminder of God's love that they can hold on to. *(if your church made stuffed elephants using the LSC pattern, please hold up.)*

In the Bible, in the book of Deuteronomy, we are reminded: *"Be careful that you do not forget the Lord..."* That seems silly, doesn't it? How could we ever forget the Lord? But as we go about our busy days with school or sports, it's easy to forget all about God.

Let's remember to be like elephants and don't forget all the wonderful things God has done for us. And let's also remember all the people helped by LSC. LSC works as God's hands in the world to make sure those in need are not forgotten.

Let's pray:

Heavenly Father, we forget things all the time, but we don't want to forget about you. Please continue to be a constant presence in our lives and in the lives of these children so that they may always know you are with them. Today as we honor LSC, bless the hands of those who do Your work on behalf of so many in need. Amen.
