Serve

Lutheran Services Carolinas would not be successful in its mission and ministry without you - its faith partners. Service can take on many forms and might include monetary support, donation collections, volunteering, advocacy, or simply a prayer for the LSC ministry. LSC values your collaboration and caring.

LSC depends on partnerships with congregations across the Carolinas. Over the last year, *your LSC ministry helped:*

- **357** children through foster care and family treatment programs.
- **82** adoptive families and completed **17** adoptions.
- **528** refugees including **342** who were newly resettled in the U.S.
- **66** unaccompanied children.
- **25** victims of human trafficking.
- **57** people with intellectual and/or developmental disabilities through supported living residences.
- **46** men and women with varying life challenges and disabilities through residential services.
- **132** people through the LSC Counseling Center.
- **53** people experiencing the symptoms of severe and persistent mental illness.
- **61** veterans facing homelessness.
- **229** families – **235** adults and **415** children – find a better future through LSC's Supportive Housing programs.
