Found Money Sunday Instructions:**

**Thank you for hosting a "Found Money" Sunday
(monetary offering) for Lutheran Services Carolinas.**

Found money is money that turns up in unexpected places or money that you were not expecting to receive. It could be loose change found in sofa cushions, between car seats, or on the sidewalk. Found money also could be an unexpected tax refund or other similar windfall.

- 1) Publicize the date of your Found Money Sunday collection in your congregation and encourage everyone to bring in their spare change. Quiet money is also appreciated, especially if members wish to share a portion of a recent tax refund or salary increase! This is an excellent opportunity to talk about the work of LSC and how the money collected will help children, adults, and families in crisis.
- 2) On the Sunday of your collection, lift up the LSC ministry and the donations collected in prayer.
- 3) Count your offerings collected from the Found Money Sunday and send a check made payable to Lutheran Services Carolinas for the total. On the memo line, put Child and Family Month. *Please don't send loose change or dollars.* Mail to Lutheran Services Carolinas, Attn: Kristen Kitchen, P.O. Box 947, Salisbury, NC 28145.
- 4) Share with your congregation the amount collected and thank them for supporting Lutheran Services Carolinas.
