A gifted and engaging speaker, Louanne's life experiences have helped shape her approach to teaching about grief. In 1996, Stanton's husband, a pastor, died at the age of 35 of a blood disorder. As she worked through her own loss, she found her purpose in life: to help people work their their grief.
